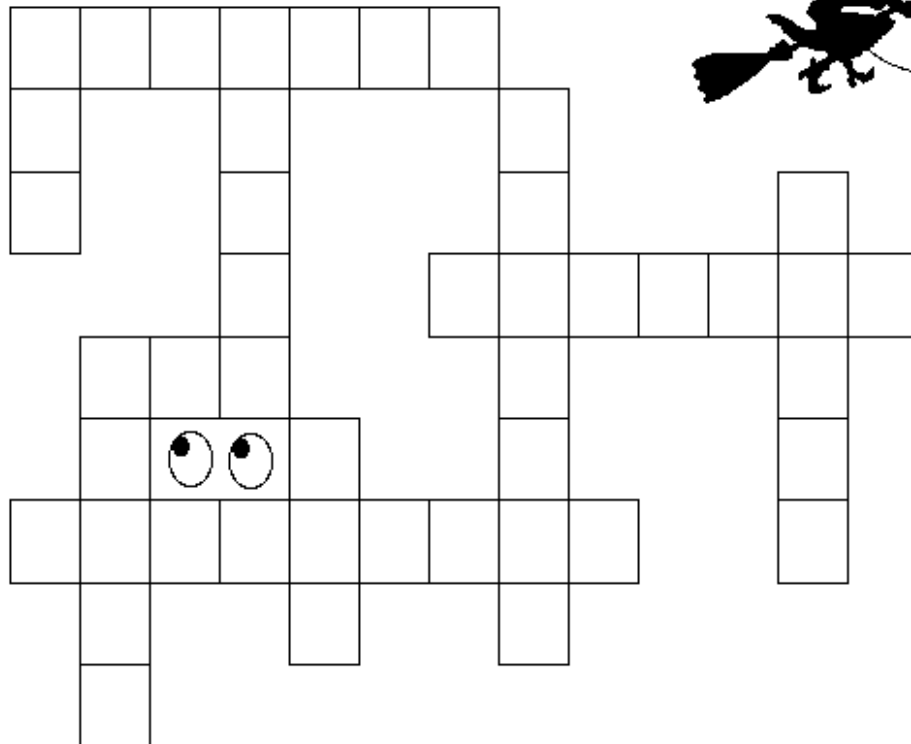

Because he had no guts.

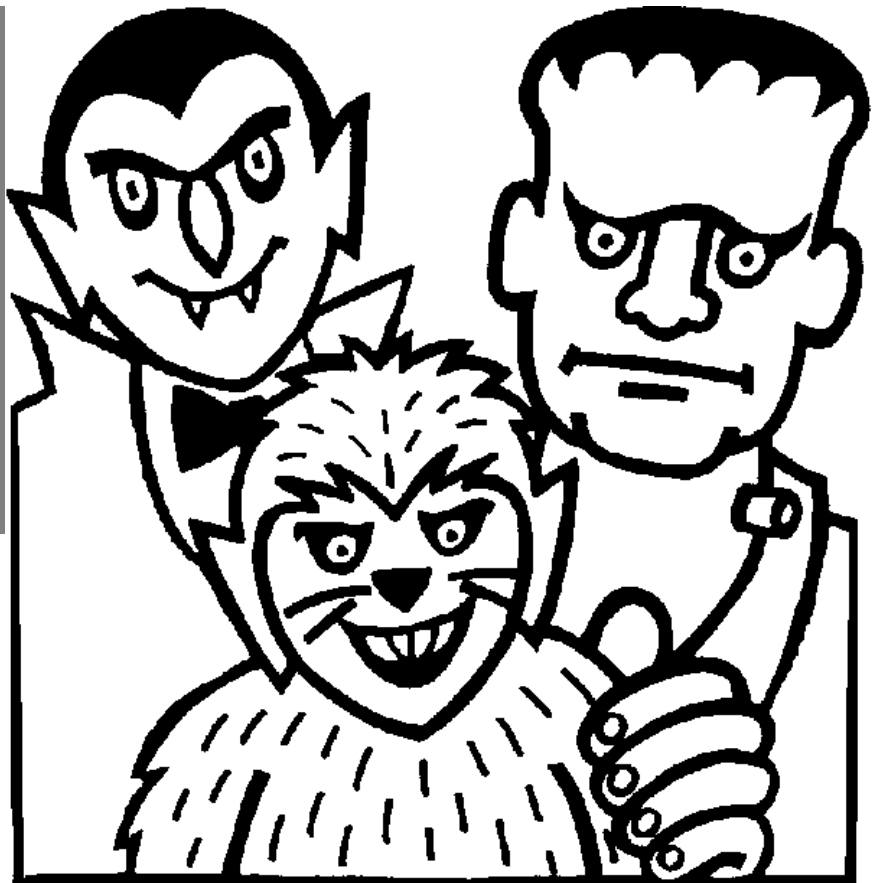
**Morgan and Casi
